- Chris- Financial update / Invoice Advertiser 2024 update—The current balance of \$125,043 reflects an increase of \$13,838 over prior month. Receipts of the 4th quarter PCA rebate of \$9,811 for new/renewing members plus a PCA surplus of \$10,996 are included. For the upcoming year, the PCA matching rebate increases from \$15.50 to \$21.00 for renewals and new members. Against billing of \$41,904 for Ads, the club has received \$19,440—about 46%. Dana requested a list of outstanding invoices for follow-up Doug requested clarification on Park Place Porsche donation to Tyler Junior College—their check remains outstanding. A full accounting for finances is attached.
- Tom/Beckie- Membership update—There were 40 new members and 3 transfers. Carey Spreen is recognized for 45 years of membership. Against 116 renewals, there were 59 non-renewals and 3 transfers out. Total membership stands at 4,079.
- Pat-Most Valuable Mav—Carey Spreen was recognized as Most Valuable Mav and will receive an Amazon gift card.

- Michael- From the Regions—The Tyler outlier trip was submitted to Panorama.
- Carey/Doug- Slipstream update—Submissions are coming, about 90% received.
- Troy- Club Ads update—Additional time in Troy's schedule will allow him to work on a few pending requests.
- Chris- Social Media update—Thanks were extended to our Facebook administrator for screening approvals. Michael Baynton is the hammer. Some graphics differences were attributed to phone based images versus computer images. Use of 'pdf' files was discouraged.

- Mark- Autocross 2024 update—Deemed 'unbelievably' fast, the Lone Star Event features 167 entries with 15 Porsches. The Women Behind the Wheel focus is scheduled for May 5th with a goal of 10 participants.
